

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
BRINGING LIGHT AND SIGHT TO SOCIETY MINISTRIES
("BLASTS Ministries")**

THE UNDERSIGNED, Kirk I. Reiten, being over the age of eighteen (18) years, for the purpose of organizing a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, does certify and execute, in triplicate, the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I
Name

The name of the corporation shall be: **"BRINGING LIGHT AND SIGHT TO SOCIETY MINISTRIES"** also doing business as but not limited to **BLASTS Ministries or (BLASTS)**.

ARTICLE II
Duration

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III
Purpose

This corporation is organized for overseeing raising funds for building up young people and for seeking out outdoor activities for persons with disabilities.

Additionally, the purpose of the corporation shall include the ability to:

Engage in and generally carry on any lawful business which may, in the judgment of the Board, at any time be necessary, useful or advantageous to this corporation, provided, however, that the corporation shall not, at any time, engage in any activities which would endanger its status as a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Washington or the United States Internal Revenue Codes.

ARTICLE IV
Registered Office and Registered Agent

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is:

ARTICLE V
Earnings

This corporation is not organized for a pecuniary profit. It shall not have any power to issue certificates of stock or declare dividends, and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any member, director or individual. The balance, if any, of all money received by the corporation from its operations, after the payment in full of all debts and obligations of the corporation of whatever kind or nature shall be used and distributed exclusively for charitable benevolent, and eleemosynary, educational, social, cultural and scientific purposes.

ARTICLE VI
Distribution upon Liquidation

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or educational or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United State Internal Revenue Code) as the Board of Directors shall determine.

ARTICLE VII
Specific Prohibitions

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on:

1. By a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

2. By a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE VIII

ARTICLE IX
Committees

This article of incorporation shall be effective upon filing and acceptance by the Secretary of State of State of Washington.
